Make and complete a multiplication chart.

Perimeter= add up all the sides


Create and decorate your fraction pizza using the following information

# ELA

Read for 20 minutes and write a summary about your book. Remember the SWBST graphic organizer to help you.



Read a book and create a comic strip retelling the story. Include characters, setting, problem, solution, and any other important events.

Write an informational story explaining the steps needed to create/do something. It could be how to make a certain type of food, build something, how to create a specific art project, game tips, etc.

Create a list of 10 questions to ask an adult in your family about their childhood. Conduct an interview with the adult and write a summary of the responses. Use the SWBST organizer for your summary.

Write an opinion piece about something you feel strongly about. Make sure you include a strong opinion, three reasons with examples, and state your opinion again. You should have 5 paragraphs using the OREO format.

Write a story about your day off from school. Be sure your story has a beginning, middle, end, and that you use dialogue. Illustrate a picture to go with the story.

Read a book and write a letter to a friend recommending the book or not. Explain why your friend should read it or why your friend shouldn't read it.

Read a book and create a bookmark about your story. Include the title of the book. Decorate your bookmark with illustrations to show characters, setting, and details about the story. Be creative and remember to color.
